All exchange students are required to live on campus, usually in Mercer Hall, the Garden Apartments, or the Lofts, and purchase a meal plan through Mercer University.

Insurance is required. Mercer offers health insurance to students. Students may purchase a plan that meets the U.S. requirements for J-1 students and waive the University insurance if preferred. Some plans may be less expensive.

Books may be purchased in a bundle at \$24/credit hour with a maximum of \$432 in book charges, or students may waive the bundle and purchase books independently.

Students need to submit documentation showing they have the funds necessary to cover the costs of attendance in the chart on the left.

Documentation must either be in US\$ or include a currency conversion. Scholarship letters, financial aid letters, or letters from the bank are acceptable, but should be written in English or have an unofficial translation attached.

Bank statements may reflect only liquid funds. Financial statements from investment funds are not acceptable.

Acceptable documents include:
