

- Must be taking 6 credits to get half time for:
 - > Federal and State Financial Aid

Money & Study Abroad

Gilman Scholarship

- > Pell Grant recipients
- > Up to \$5,000
- Critical language component
- > 80% of our students who apply receive the scholarship


Global Leader Scholarship

- > Up to \$8,000
- Based on financial need
- Mercer based scholarship

Fund for Education Abroad

- > any length program
- High-financial need, students of color, community college, and first-generation college students given preference
- **>** \$1,250-\$10,000

Mercer Cost


- > Tuition- \$21,635/semester
- > Housing- \$3,794/double
- ➤ Meal plan- \$3,879/semester

\$29,308/semester

O Vietnam (Affiliate)

- > Tuition, Room, & Board-\$5,780/semester
- > Flight- \$1,500
- Mercer aid not applicable

\$7,280/semester


